A Strong, Social and Liveable Community

19 1. Responsible Public Finances

20 We believe in sound municipal finances as the basis for trust and long-term
21 stability. Disciplined budgeting and sustainable planning allow us to invest
22 wisely while keeping local taxes low.

23 2. Efficient and Modern Local Governance

24 A professional and service-oriented administration is an important location
25 factor. By cooperating closely with neighboring municipalities, we reduce
26 bureaucracy and improve efficiency.

27 3. Supporting Business, Innovation, and Local Enterprise

28 Bickenbach benefits from its proximity to universities, research institutions,
29 and international companies. A dedicated economic liaison strengthens
30 dialogue between business, science, and local government.

31 4. A Family-Friendly Place to Live

32 Reliable childcare with flexible hours and high quality standards supports
33 families, international professionals, and long-term settlement in our
34 community.

35 5. Accessible Healthcare Close to Home

36 We work toward sustainable healthcare solutions, including a local medical
37 center and complementary services that improve access for all residents.

39 Thoughtful residential development ensures quality of life today and
40 tomorrow. The “Bachgewann” area will be developed holistically, with

51 non-bureaucratic exchange and self-organised initiatives.

54 and initiatives focus on bringing people together.

55 **11. Strengthening Community Spaces**

56 Shared infrastructure such as a new sports hall and communal facilities
57 strengthens social interaction and a sense of belonging.

59 Well-maintained roads and infrastructure support mobility, economic
60 activity, and everyday life – planned sustainably and based on real needs.
